Who is it for?	As this is a knowledge qualification it is not essential that you are in work but it is most likely that you will be employed as a middle manager. There are no specific entry requirements however you should have a minimum of level two in literacy and numeracy or equivalent.
What is included in the qualification?	The qualification consists of mandatory units, covering principles of management and leadership, strategic business management and planning and strategic decision-making, and a wide range of optional units including: Principles of business finance Customer Relationship Management Business Process Management Strategic Project Management Principles of Operational Planning The qualification is a knowledge element of the Higher Apprenticeship in Management
