What are the primary and other purposes /outcomes?	The purpose of the qualification is to develop your skills and competence if you are a middle manager to enable you to lead and manage individuals and teams, develop strategic plans and manage strategic change. The qualification is suitable for managers in a wide range of occupations and sectors and provides the opportunity to demonstrate management skills. All the learning is vocational.
Who is it for?	The qualification is suitable for you if you are already employed in a management role as it requires assessment of work competence. There are no specific entry requirements however learners should have a minimum of level two in literacy and numeracy or equivalent.
What is included in the qualification?	The qualification is made up of mandatory and optional units so that the content can be chosen to meet your needs. The mandatory units cover: contributing to the development of a strategic plan, designing business processes, managing strategic change and providing leadership and management. The optional units cover a wide range of topics relating to, for example: risk management, equality of opportunity, staff development, operational planning, tendering and project management. The qualification is the competence element of the Higher Apprenticeship in Management.
What could the qualification lead to?	Achievement of the qualification could lead to further qualifications such as: Level 6 Diploma in Management and Leadership Level 6 Diploma in Strategic HR Management Level 6 Diploma in Marketing Management You could also progress to higher education to undertake business related or other qualifications, including degrees in areas such as business, business management, and business administration or: business and management undergraduate programmes, business or management professional qualifications at level 5 and above, opportunities within their current job role/alternative job roles specialised qualifications providing additional technical knowledge progression to job roles such as operations director, business development manager, company secretary
Structure/ rule of combination	Learners must achieve a minimum of 53 credits: 22 credits from Mandatory Group A and a minimum of 23 credits from Optional Group B. A maximum of 8 credits can come from Optional Group C.
Type of assessment	A portfolio of evidence which meets the learning outcomes and assessment criteria of the chosen units.
